

In addition, all insects . . .

- · have a hard outer covering called an exoskeleton;
- breathe air through openings called spiracles along the thorax;
- · lay eggs;
- grow through a process called metamorphosis. Babies are called larvas or nymphs. They shed their skin and change form in stages to become adults.

And most insects ...

- · have one pair of antennas;
- · have two pairs of wings. The wings and legs are attached to the thorax.
